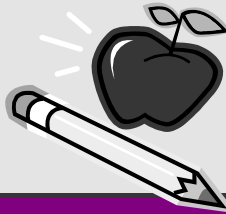

I would like to take this opportunity to welcome back all our children and parents. We have been so impressed by the positive attitude of the children and how smart they look both in class and for P.E.

This term's learning is centered on a key theme which is '**The Battle of Britain**'. As always, we welcome any support from home and encourage the children to extend their learning.

Y6 Homework Timetable

*Reading daily is essential in order for the children to progress and develop in all areas of the curriculum. We expect the children to **read every night** at home. They **MUST** read their school stage books and they may read their own book in addition. A love for reading will really help them for High School and regular practise establishes that passion for reading.*

*We will be setting **spellings** on Spelling Shed and a paper copy which can be kept at home. The children will be tested upon their spellings weekly on a Friday.*

Year 6 learn and practise a times table each week, which will also be tested on a Friday.

Using TTRockstars for 10 minutes every evening will improve speed, accuracy and they have fun.

Rapid, accurate recall of their times tables is essential skill for the year ahead and High School. A maths homework book with vital revision facts and additional daily activities to complete will be sent home. These will be fully explained in class.

A regular, consistent approach to homework will tremendously benefit them this year. A copy of all of the children's passwords and login details will be sent home.
